Expanded Duty Dental Assisting Certification

Enhance your knowledge in chair side assisting and expand your employment opportunities

This course provides advanced training and skills to individuals who are currently trained as Dental Assistant. This didactic and laboratory experience will include the following:

- Understand terminology, morphology, and occlusion
- Identify various cavity classifications
- Preparation and placement of dental dam
- Assembly and placement of matrices and wedges
- Packing, carving, finishing, and polishing amalgams and composite restorations
- Proper elastomeric impression techniques
- Creation of provisional crowns and bridges

Prerequisites and participation requirements:

- All students must be currently employed as a chair side dental assistant and have a minimum of one year full time chair side employment completed.
- All students must wear appropriate PPE during ALL laboratory exercises. Students
 must provide their own protective eye wear and lab coats. FAILURE TO WEAR
 APPROPRIATE PPE WILL RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM CLASS AND STUDENT WILL
 NOT RECEIVE A CERTIFICATE FOR THE CLASS.
- Student's nails must NOT be artificial, long, or polished for participation in this course.
- Students MUST attend ALL classes as time is scheduled. ANY ABSENCES, LATE ARRIVALS, OR EARLY DEPARTURES WILL RESULT IN NOT RECEIVING A CERTIFICATE FOR THIS CLASS

DEA 275 Special Topics: Expanded Duty

Provides didactic and laboratory experience in packing, carving, finishing and polishing of Class I, II and V amalgams and Class III, IV and V tooth colored restorations and the fabrication of provisional restorations. Operative procedures include placement of matrices and wedges. Laboratory exercises involve the use of typodonts and prepared teeth that are utilized in restorative procedures. Use of principles of four-handed dentistry and time utilization are an integral part of fulfilling requirements leading toward proficiency in restorative procedures.
