### **Final Steps**

- → Once all components have been completed, <u>submit all required documents</u> to the Pickens Technical College Registration Office located in Building B.
- → Deadline for submitting completed applications:

◆ Fall/August Entrance: First Monday of April◆ Spring/January Entrance: First Monday of October

- → Once applications have been reviewed, applicants will be notified regarding whether or not they will move forward to the interview.
- → After interviews have been conducted, applicants will be notified by email within approximately 1 month as to whether they have been: Accepted, Waitlisted, or Declined.
