SEMESTER 1

FMT 1201 Maintenance–Electricity

4 credits

Electrical fundamentals as applied to residential and commercial facilities maintenance. Covers repair, service, and maintenance of electrical systems and codes.

OSH 1300 10HR OSHA Voluntary Compliance

1 credit

10-hour OSHA General Industry course covering current 29 CFR 1910 standards. Taught by OSHA-certified instructors; completers receive a certificate from the U.S. Department of Labor, OSHA.

CON 1012 Basic Repairs for Home or Apartment

4 credits

Focuses on the repair and maintenance of buildings. Covers preventative maintenance methods and skills.

PLU 1001 Piping Skills

4 credits

Installation of common piping in plumbing, pipe math, terminology, materials, offsets, joints, support/hanging, center-to-center measurements, and various pipe-joining methods.

SEMESTER 2

FMT 1102 Swimming Pool Maintenance

2 credits

Focuses on the fundamentals of pool operation and maintenance techniques for private and public swimming pools. Includes Certified Pool Operator Certification.

FMT 2701 Appliance Technology I

7 credits

Examines mechanical systems, water distribution, and electrical and gas systems of laundry equipment. This course includes service and repair on washers and dryers.

FMT 2702 Appliance Technology II

7 credits

Examines mechanical systems, water distribution, and electrical and gas components of kitchen equipment. This course covers service and repair on dishwashers, disposals, ranges, and microwave ovens. Includes EPA 608 Certification.

FMT 2085 Independent Study

2 credits

Meets the individual needs of students. Students engage in intensive study or research under the direction of a qualified instructor.
