The Facilities Maintenance Technician program prepares students with entry level skills to perform inspection, preventive maintenance and repairs on residential and commercial properties. Successful graduates will possess knowledge and skills in the basic maintenance of carpentry, plumbing, electrical, major appliances, HVAC, swimming pools, and other mechanical systems. Instruction will also include interior facilities maintenance finish work such as floors, walls, painting, window treatments, ceiling/exhaust fans and lighting.
